

# 2009 CHASKA WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE RULES

1. All players must live or work in School District #112. Any violation of this rule will result in an automatic team expulsion from the league.
2. Anyone participating in the league must be a rostered player. Roster changes may be made at any time during the season by having the person sign the roster at the Park & Recreation office.
3. I need your help to keep accurate standings. Please have only the winning team fill out the score sheet. If you record a score from a different week, please mark the date. If you are playing at the CCC record your score at the front desk.
4. If school closes due to bad weather, the CMSE gym is not available and all games are cancelled. If there is a question about playing because of bad weather after school lets out, please call the Park & Recreation rainout line at 448-5633 x4.
5. If you cannot play on a particular evening, you are responsible for calling the opposite team manager. A manager's list is enclosed. There are no make-up dates available.
6. Children are not to be brought to games. There is neither the space nor supervision to accommodate them.
7. There is no penalty if you have less than 6 players. You can play with any number less than 6, even 3. All games must start within 10 minutes of game time.
- \*8. Serves and spikes may be received by a bump or set. \*A spike is an attack play in which the ball is forcibly hit into the opponents court with a one-hand overhead motion. This does not apply when a player uses a drive technique. \*A drive is an overhead pass (much like a serve) that is generally hit from the back row over the net.
9. Rally point on tied games: when your 45 or 60 minute game time is up and the game is tied, we'll be doing a rally point. This rule simply states the first team to score a point, regardless of who served, wins the game.
10. If the ball hits the baskets directly above the playing court at the CMSE or the batting cage at the CCC and falls back on your side you can play it. If it falls back on your opponent's side it is a side out.
11. Teams may serve from anywhere behind the back line from the left out of bounds line to the right.
12. All players must be 18 years of age to play in this league.
13. You may not play a ball that is on or over an adjacent court. You may not play a ball and then have your body cross over onto an adjacent court. This will result in a side out.
14. If teams cannot agree on a particular call, please re-do the play.
